LEARN AT YOUR LEVEL

Weekly practices on Tuesday at 7pm

Beginner — 1 hour per week

Intermediate — 1.5 hours per week

Competition Band — 2 hours per week

Students learn in small groups and progress at their own pace, with weekly instruction designed for each level.

What do you need?

Beginner pipers only need their own practice chanter to get started (As they progress to the bagpipes, loaner bagpipes are available, so families don't need to purchase a full set right away).

TRAVEL & ADVENTURE

Members have opportunities to perform at community events, parades, and concerts throughout the year. At the competitive level, players may also participate in competitions across Alberta and Canada.

These experiences give kids the chance to perform for new audiences, travel with their teammates, and experience the excitement of being part of a pipe band — while building confidence, friendships, and memories along the way.
